A substantial selection of native and non-native annuals, biennials and perennials designed to provide continuous blooming color throughout the growing season. For use in landscaping and beautification applications desiring a dense array of seasonal color. When given sufficient time to flower, pollinate and set seed, annuals and biennials will reseed themselves in subsequent years. Provides excellent forage and habitat for pollinator species such as bees, butterflies and hummingbirds.
